



Rv—Rendezvous Townhomes

Combinations of tri-plex and five-plex townhomes were designed to coordinate among the varied housing in the resort community of Rendezvous.

The design introduces diversity into the offerings at Rendezvous, providing a direct connection to the incredible natural landscape and the outdoor lifestyle of Colorado mountain resort living. Taking advantage of the natural topography, 3 levels of living are vertically integrated and tailored to accommodate both intimate retreats as well as larger social gatherings.

The townhomes offer a blend of natural, organic materials while allowing an honest architecture to emerge, avoiding the usual trappings and additives of “mountain” architecture. The forms are direct and honest, with the detailing resulting from an exploitation of the incredible views, diverse seasonal changes and natural lighting.

Doug Fir structural beams and posts are balanced with a mix of cor-ten “rusty” steel roofs and exterior siding, providing a direct link to the forms and materials of the regions architectural lineage.

Private patios, complete with outdoor fireplaces, extend the living space year round integrating the open living spaces visually to the sunning diverse landscape beyond.
